Minutes: Minutes of the January 9, 2006, meeting were distributed. Motion to approve minutes as presented by Bryan, second by Henning. Motion passed.

Supervisor's Report: The Airport is at full hangar rental capacity and have six individuals on waiting list for T-Hangars. Maintenance is on track. An aerial service out of Atlanta helped boost fuel sales while doing work in and around Findlay.

Airport Projects Update: Duane Johnson of R.W. Armstrong on the following projects:

*Runway 7-25 Rehabilitation:* The contractor is working on a few cleanup items that will be completed in the next month.

*Taxiway B Extension and Rehabilitation:* The project is scheduled to be advertised and bid in May/June, with the bids due on June 16. Construction to start in August/September and last for approximately 2 months.

*Apron Expansion and Runway 7-25 Safety Area Improvements:* Planning to expand the apron and regrade the safety area on the southeast end of Runway 7-25. A reduction in the Runway 7-25 Safety Area grading is under review by the FAA. Grading may be limited to the area just east of Runway 18-36.

*Relocate Taxiway A:* Planning to relocate Taxiway A to a 400' separation from Runway 18-36 to be phased from 2008-2010.

*Runway 7-25 and Runway 18-36 PAPI Replacement (2008):* Replace existing PAPIs.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned.
