Whereas: Nearly 1,700,000 outstanding members have earned the highest honor bestowed on a Scout - the Eagle Scout award; and


Now, Therefore, I, Pete Sehnert, Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio, do hereby proclaim February 10, 2009, as:
