1. Request of Superintendent Wittwer, Findlay City Schools, to change the one-way direction of Cory Street between West Main Cross Street and West Front Street to a one-way going south

Superintendent Wittwer stated that the Findlay City Schools have been looking into the best way to drop off and pick up students at Central Middle School. Twice a day during the school year one lane of West Main Cross is shut off for buses and parents picking up and dropping off. Chief DeVore asked why Cory Street? Superintendent Wittwer stated that they have looked at all the streets and thought Cory Street would be the safest for the students. Chief DeVore and Chief Spraw stated that Cory Street was used a lot for an emergency route. Superintendent Wittwer asked for suggestions.

Motion by Councilman Monday to table request until a delegation of Traffic Commission meets with members of City Findlay Schools, second by Chief DeVore. Motion passed 4-0.
