OLD BUSINESS

Request of John Crom, Blanchard Valley Center, to install a yellow warning flasher for the school zone on East Sandusky Street by the school.

The Mayor asked if Blanchard Valley Center would pay 50% of the cost of electrical, just as Findlay City School does. Mr. Crom said he could not answer that today.

Motion by Chief Lonyo to table the request to get the cost of the lights/electrical, second by Chief Spraw. Motion passed 3-0.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Request of W. H. Conlisk, Marathon Petroleum Company, to:
 - a. Install new crosswalk signage and striping on East Hardin Street immediately south of the main entrance to the Marathon Building and Marketing Building.
 - b. Restripe the crosswalks located on Beech Avenue at the north and south intersections of East Hardin Street.

Brian met with Marathon before regarding this request after an accident happened. This request abides with the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for mid block crosswalks. Mid block crosswalks signage and striping has been updated in the past year, so signage and striping will be new. The striping is temperature sensitive, so will have to wait until the temperatures are in the 50-60's to restripe.

Motion by Chief Spraw to approve the requests, second by Chief Lonyo. Motion passed 3-0.

OTHER BUSINESS

Discussion was made regarding 20 MPH flashing signs at Glenwood and Washington Schools and hours when flashing. The Commission will look at the Findlay Codified Ordinance regarding hours and send a letter to Findlay City Schools.
