NEW BUSINESS

1. Request of Lori Scarberry, 517 W. Foulke, to install a sign in alley west of 517 W. Foulke Avenue to remind vehicles to proceed slowly due to property owners exiting their driveways.

The alley is just like every other alley in Findlay. The property area is big enough that cars backing out of driveways are able to see oncoming traffic

Motion by Brian Hurt to deny request, second by Chief Lonyo. Motion passed 3-0.

2. Request of Martin Terry, The University of Findlay, to move the 25 MPH area further north from Washington School.

The area by the university doesn't fit the criteria for 25 MPH. There are ample crosswalks and they have pedestrian push buttons.

Motion by Chief Lonyo to deny request, second by Brian Hurt. Motion passed 3-0.

Request of Martin Terry, The University of Findlay, to install "The University of Findlay, English Equestrian Farm" with arrow pointing east sign; at the corner of Olive Street and South Main Street.

Motion by Chief Lonyo to table request so commission members can take a look at area, second by Brian Hurt. Motion passed 3-0.
