NEW BUSINESS

1. Request of Sam Littlepage, 1005 Blanchard Avenue, to install "No Parking" signs in front of the old school building on Blanchard Avenue

Mr. Littlepage stated about a year ago a truck started parking in front of the school building every now and then. Then it started to be on a regular basis. It was blocking his view, so it must be blocking the school bus driver's view. Mr. Littlepage passed out photos of the trucks that park there on a regular basis. He doesn't feel it is safe. Council Monday stated that he talked to a couple of bus drivers that use that route and they agreed it was hard to see. Chief Spraw said according to the City ordinance it is illegal to park there unless he has permission from the property owner. Chief Lonyo wondered how far down you would have to go for placing signs. Councilman Monday suggested no parking between signs

Motion by Councilman Monday to install "No Parking Between Signs" strategically located from the edge of the driveway of the old school building to east of the property line of Thiel Chiropractic, second by Chief Spraw. Motion passed 4-0.


2. Request of a concerned citizen, to install a device on West Sandusky to slow traffic coming from the west by Liberty Benton School into town.

There is one speed limit sign by the interstate and Western Avenue when you come off of Route 12 east bound and people drive about 60 MPH all the way to Glessner Avenue. Chief Spraw suggested putting "Reduce Speed Ahead" signs

Motion by Chief Spraw to install "Reduce Speed Ahead" signs at the City limits east of Emma Street, second by Brian Hurt. Motion passed 4-0.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 3:00 PM. The next meeting of the City of Findlay Traffic Commission will be held at 2:30 PM, in the Municipal Building 3rd Floor Conference Room on Monday, June 16, 2008.
