NEW BUSINESS

1. Request of Joe Tracy, to install street signs in the Forest Lake subdivision in the area of Brookfield Drive.

Brian Hurt stated that the signs in that subdivision are the decorative street signs on top of the AEP poles.

Motion by Brian Hurt to take triage to see if developer should address this instead of the City. If it is determined that it needs to come back to Traffic Commission for signage, we will bring it back at a later date, second by CPT Horne. Motion passed 3-0.

2. Request of Police Chief Spraw to have school zone signs removed, including crosswalk signs at St. Mike's downtown school.

Chief Spraw has spoken to the principal at St. Mikes and there are no school functions there and no plans in the near future for any school to relocate.

Motion by CPT Horne to remove school zone signs including crosswalk signs at St. Mike's downtown school, second by Brian Hurt. Motion passed 3-0.

3. Request of Matt Myers, Findlay Fire Department, to install an Opticon at the intersection of Main and Trenton in 2008.

Public Works ordered 5 opticons for this year. They will take the one that was going to be used at Cooper and put it at Main and Trenton since it is a more dangerous intersection and replace the one at Cooper next year.

Motion by Brian Hurt to approve request at the discretion of the Traffic Lights Department, second by CPT Horne. Motion passed 3-0.


4. Request of Mary Gerber, 1221 Winchester Ct., to install "No Outlet" sign on Winchester Ct.
