NEW BUSINESS

1. Request of Rev. Rick Humphreys, First Assembly of God, 124 Ash Avenue, to install eight small signs noting the location of First Assembly of God in Findlay.

Rev. Humphreys stated that the church is celebrating their 100 years of service in Findlay and they wanted to put the signs up noting the location of the church in Findlay. Chief Spraw was concerned that this would spur other churches to ask for the same kind of request. Councilman Monday stated that he thought it was a good idea, but he cannot support it because Findlay has 30-40 churches in Findlay.

Motion by Chief Lonyo to place 2 signs on Main Street at Ash Avenue, one northbound and one southbound, at the churches expense, second by Councilman Monday. Motion passed 3-1 with Brian Hurt casting the dissenting vote.


2. Request of Jeff Jenson, 124 E. Wallace Street, to install "No Parking" sign for small area between his driveway and the new parking lot next to his house owned by the hospital.

Mr. Jenson stated that Blanchard Valley Hospital bought the church that was there and tore it down and made a parking lot. There is a small area between his driveway and the parking lot where vehicles are parking and it makes it difficult to see when backing out of driveway. Brian Hurt agreed that it is a problem and shouldn't have parking there.

Motion by Brian Hurt to grant request and install "No Parking sign per Engineer Department and Public Works, second by Councilman Monday. Motion passed 4-0.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 2:55 PM. The next meeting of the City of Findlay Traffic Commission will be held at 2:30 PM, in the Municipal Building 3rd Floor Conference Room on Monday, September 17, 2007.
