NEW BUSINESS

1. Request of Paulette Weiser, Hancock Historical Museum, to place permanent marker in the City right-of-way area between the sidewalk and the curb in front of Mason Chapel A.M.E. Church at 845 Liberty Street.

The church received approval for an Ohio State Historical Marker commemorating the long history of the church. The narrative on the marker wraps around front to back. Would like the sign to be placed at right angles between the two handicap parking signs that already exist. The sign is 44 inches wide and 44 inches tall and has a seven foot post. It was recommend by the Commission to call OUPS, Ohio Utilities Protection Services, before you dig.

Motion by Chief Lonyo to grant request, second by Councilman Monday. Motion passed 4-0.

2. Request of Karen Crawford, House of Awards, placement of parking signs.

Hose of Awards recently moved their business north to 419 North Main Street. Due to confusion of customers on whether they can park on Main Street, would like "No Parking Here to Corner" sign and to repaint the corner yellow. The Commission members felt that a sign would be confusing because of the alley that is nearby. Thought it would be best to stripe parking spots, repaint the curbs yellow, and take out current sign.

Motion by Councilman Monday to mark appropriately for adequate parking, second by Brian Hurt. Motion passed 4-0.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 2:55 PM. The next meeting of the City of Findlay Traffic Commission will be held at 2:30 PM, in the Municipal Building 3rd Floor Conference Room on Monday, April 16th.
